

INFORMATION CONCERNING PERSONAL DATA

Bearing in mind the applicable rules of personal data protection, we would like to inform you that in the event of starting cooperation: (i) The administrator of your personal data is BIOFEED sp.z o.o., with its registered office at ul. JESIONOWA 28, 83-130 RAJKOWY, registered in the register of entrepreneurs by the District Court Gdańsk-Północ in Gdańsk, 7th Commercial Division of the National Court Register under KRS number: 0000305450, REGON number: 22059637600000, NIP number: 5932524603, share capital PLN 360,500 ("Administrator") (ii) Personal data will be processed by BIOFEED sp. Z oo, in particular pursuant to Article 6 (1) (b) and (c) and (f), also if the processing is based on consent pursuant to (a) GDPR * in purpose: performance of activities for which the data subject has consented to take action prior to the conclusion of the contract at the request of the data subject or performance of the contract to which the data subject is a party, fulfillment of the legal obligation incumbent on the Administrator or actions in the scope of laundering legitimate interests data administrator. The scope of the data includes: data necessary to conclude a contract / fulfill an order /, (iii) Personal data will be processed by BIOFEED sp. based on the legitimate interest of BIOFEED sp.z o.o. i.e. pursuant to Art. 6 sec. 1 lit. f GDPR for the purpose of: marketing of own products or services (i.e. BIOFEED sp. z oo), organizing and conducting competitions and other marketing campaigns, pursuing or securing claims, conducting quality analyzes of services and goods delivered, which means that BIOFEED sp. o. o it will not made available these data differently as for the purposes of the contract / your order /, (iv) Personal data will also be processed by BIOFEED sp.z o.o. on the basis of a separate consent, i.e. pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 lit. a GDPR and in order to provide the customer with information about changes to the Agreement, including, for example, the Regulations / Price List, about changing the name (company), address or registered office, confirming the receipt of the complaint and responding to it to the indicated e-mail address (e-mail), (v) Personal data processed in order to conclude or perform the contract / order fulfillment / and fulfill the Administrator's legal obligation will be kept for the period of cooperation or the duration of the contract, and after its expiry for the period necessary for: after-sales customer service (e.g. handling complaints), securing or pursuing or defending any claims, fulfilling the Administrator's legal obligation (e.g. resulting from tax or accounting regulations) in accordance with the law, (vi) Personal data processed for the marketing of BIOFEED sp. z oo products or own services on the basis of a legitimate legal interest, will be processed until the data subject submits an objection. Personal data processed on the basis of a separate consent will be stored for the purpose for which the consent was given until its revocation. In the event of consent to the processing of data by the Administrator for the purposes of the Administrator's marketing, the data will be processed only for the duration of the contract, or until such consent is withdrawn (vii) The data will not be profiled automatically, the data will not be transferred to third countries (i.e. outside the European Area Gospodarczego), (viii). quality, audit services. In particular, you have the following rights: (1) the right to access your personal data, i.e. the right to obtain confirmation whether the Administrator processes data and information regarding such processing, (2) the right to rectify data if the data processed by the Administrator is incorrect or incomplete, (3) the right to request the Administrator to delete data, (4) the right to request the Administrator to limit data processing, (5) the right to transfer data, i.e. the right to receive personal data provided to the Administrator and send them to another administrator, (6) the right to object to the processing of data on the basis of the Administrator's legitimate interest or to processing for marketing purposes, (7) the right to lodge a complaint with the Polish supervisory authority or supervisory authority of another European Union Member State, competent for the place of habitual residence or work of the data subject or with due to the place of the alleged violation of the GDPR, (8) the right to withdraw consent at any time (without affecting the lawfulness of the processing which was carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal), (9) the right to obtain intervention from The administrator, expressing his own position and to challenge the decision based on data processing. The rights listed above can be exercised by contacting an employee of BIOFEED sp.z o.o. or by contacting them by traditional mail to the Administrator's address. Sending this message was preceded by a question for consent to receive it or constitutes a reply to the recipient's earlier message. In the event of an incorrect definition of the recipient of the message, please delete it, ignore it and understand it.

COOKIES POLICY

This Cookie Policy sets out the rules for the use of cookies on the website administered by BIOFEED sp.z o.o. under the domain www.biofeedgloba.com

§ 1 Definitions - in the field of cookies policy

1. Website Operator - means BIOFEED sp.z o.o., with its seat at ul. JESIONOWA 28, 83-130 RAJKOWY, registered in the register of entrepreneurs by the District Court Gdańsk-Północ in Gdańsk, 7th Commercial Division of the National Court Register under KRS number: 0000305450, REGON number: 22059637600000, NIP number: 5932524603, share capital PLN 360 500
2. Cookies - means IT data, in particular small text files, saved and stored on devices through which the User uses the Website's pages.
3. Website - means the website where the Operator runs the website, operating in the domain www.biofeedglobal.com
4. Device - means an electronic device through which the User gains access to the Website pages.
5. User - means an entity for which services may be provided on the Website.

Types of cookies used.

1. The cookies used by the Operator are safe for the User's Device. In particular, it is not possible for viruses or other unwanted software or malware to enter Users' Devices this way. These files allow to identify the software used by the User and adjust the Website to the User's individual needs. Cookies usually contain the name of the domain they come from, the storage time on the Device and the assigned value.
2. The operator uses two types of cookies:
 - a) session cookies: they are stored on the User's Device and remain there until the end of the browser session. The saved information is then permanently deleted from the Device's memory. The mechanism of session cookies does not allow the collection of any personal data or any confidential information from the User's Device.

b) persistent cookies: they are stored on the User's Device and remain there until they are deleted. Ending a browser session or turning off the Device does not delete them from the User's Device. The mechanism of persistent cookies does not allow the collection of any personal data or any confidential information from the User's Device.

3. The User has the option to limit or disable the access of cookies to his Device. If you use this option, the use of the Website will be possible with limitations, i.e. except for functions that, by their nature, require cookies.

The purposes for which cookies are used.

Cookies are used on the Website for statistical purposes (regarding visit statistics) and to ensure the proper operation of the Website and provide more tailored content.

The website operator uses cookies to correctly configure the website, in particular to:

- a) adjusting the content of the Website pages to the User's preferences and optimizing the use of the Website pages.
- b) logging in to the website
- c) maintaining the user's login on each subsequent page of the website.

Managing cookies.

1. The user may grant or refuse consent to the use of cookies through the settings of his browser. These settings can be changed in particular in such a way as to block the automatic handling of cookies in the web browser settings or to inform about each time cookies are placed on the User's device. Detailed information on how to handle cookies is available in the web browser settings.
